

Special Council Meeting
City of Tallulah
June 08, 2020

A special council meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Monday, June 08, 2020 at 5:30 P. M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and asked for a moment of silent prayer.

Michael Goods Utility Manager explained the need for both the excavator and the crawler dump truck to remove the lime from the ditch. The lime accumulated due to the fact that the aerator was not working. Since the aerator has been installed, less lime is used. Mr. Goods stated that this was also part of the Administrative Order. The plan is to build a dam about fifty feet away from the gate of the plant to channel the lime in a different direction to help prevent the buildup.
