

Regular Council Meeting
City of Tallulah
April 22, 2021

A regular meeting of the City Council was held on Thursday, April 22, 2021, at 5:30 P. M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and a moment of silence was held.

Time was allowed for public comment regarding items on the agenda, but there was none.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the April 8, 2021 meeting were made by Councilmembers Day and Whitney respectively and carried unanimously.

Police Chief Buster McCoy asked that 3 part-time police officers be added to his force. Subsequent motion to approve the employment of Officers Brianna Jones, Jonathon Jones, and Edward Nash on a part-time basis was made by Councilmember Robinson, seconded by Councilmember Day, and carried unanimously.

Motion and second to approve the occupational license of Natalie Devine, dba, "Devine Helping Hands Childcare." were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Sims respectively and carried unanimously.

Councilmember Scott moved for the approval of A Resolution Authorizing and Providing for the Incurrence of Indebtedness for the Purpose of Providing a Portion of the Costs of Acquiring, Constructing, Enlarging, Improving and/or Extending the Tallulah Water Plant. Councilmember Whitney seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Motion was made by Councilmember Day to approve A Resolution for the City of Tallulah Approving the Application for Grant Funds from the FHWA Recreational Trails Program for Louisiana (FRTPL) as Established by CFDA 20.219. Councilmember Whitney seconded, and motion carried unanimously. The grant will allow the construction of new sidewalks in several walkways within the City as outlined by Administrative Assistant, Yvonne Lewis in presenting an overview of the project.


