

Regular Council Meeting  
City of Tallulah  
July 22, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, July 22, 2021, at 5:30 P.M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and a moment of silence was held.

Mayor Finlayson gave a brief update on the new city water well that is to be drilled and explained accomplishments being made toward that end.

Mayor Finlayson allowed a moment for anyone to make comments regarding items on the agenda, but there was none.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the July 8, 2021, regular meeting were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Sims respectively and carried unanimously.

A briefing scheduled on Section 8 Housing was deferred until next meeting.

Regarding the annual City financial audit, motion to approve an engagement letter from LaPorte CPAs was made by Councilmember Whitney, seconded by Councilmember Robinson, and carried unanimously.

Motion to enter Public Hearing was made by Councilmembers Sims and Whitney respectively and carried unanimously.

In Public Hearing, the topic of discussion was: An Ordinance Authorizing The Issuance Of Seven Million Ninety Five thousand Dollars (\$7,095,000) Water System Revenue Refunding Bonds, Series 2021, Of The City Of Tallulah, State of Louisiana; Prescribing The Form, Terms And Conditions Of Said Bonds, Designating The Date, Denomination And Place Of Payment Of Said Bonds; Providing For The Payment Thereof In Principal And Interest; And Providing For Other Matters In Connection Therewith.

Motion and second to adjourn Public Hearing and re-enter Regular Session were made by Councilmembers Whitney and Sims respectively which carried unanimously.


Motion to approve the ordinance authorizing the issuance of water system revenue bonds was made by Councilmembers Sims and Whitney respectively and carried unanimously.
