

Regular Council Meeting
City of Tallulah
November 29, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Monday, November 29, 2021, at 5:30 P.M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed a moment for silent prayer.

During the time allowed, there were no comments from the public regarding any items on the agenda.

Motion and second to approve the minutes of November 10, 2021 meeting were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Day respectively and carried unanimously

Councilmember Whitney moved for approval of an occupational license for Ms. Dorothy Dean, dba, Gigi's Loving Touch Academy. Councilmember Robinson seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

In discussion of the two current reapportionment plans, Doug Mitchell, boundary planner, stated that he would present any discrepancies of city boundaries to the Secretary of State for correction.

Accordingly, Councilmember Robinson moved to introduce an Ordinance Adopting A Plan Of Reapportionment For The City Council Of the City Of Tallulah, Louisiana Based On The 2020 Decennial Census. Councilmember Scott seconded, and motion carried unanimously. The alternative chosen by the Council was Plan II, and Mayor Finlayson announced that there would be a Public Hearing on the redistricting plan at next regular meeting scheduled on December 16, 2021.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned on motion and second of Councilmembers Sims and Day respectively which carried unanimously.
