

Regular Council Meeting  
City of Tallulah  
November 10, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, November 10, 2021, at 5:30 P.M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed time for silent prayer.

Bill Boles, the Boles Law Firm, Monroe, Louisiana, was on hand to present an overview and explanation of: A Resolution Granting Preliminary Authority For The City Of Tallulah, State Of Louisiana, To Issue, Sell And Deliver Water Revenue Bonds, In One Or More Series, In an Amount Not To Exceed Four Million Sixty-Five Thousand Dollars (\$4,065,000). Councilmember Sims moved for approval of the resolution, and a roll call vote is shown as follows:


Motion carried.

From the government agency, North Delta Regional Planning and Development Center, administrator Douglas Mitchell gave a presentation on plans for redistricting the City's 5 districts based on the 2020 Decennial Census numbers and population shifts. He explained differences in population shifts and loss/gain numbers among city districts and laid out Plan A and Plan B as two alternative plans which would suffice boundary-wise in producing relative equality in population among city districts. Mayor Finlayson stated that Mr. Mitchell would return for next council meeting, and that hopefully the Council would approve one of the alternative plans.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned on motion and second of Councilmembers Robinson and Day respectively and carried unanimously.
