Motion and second to approve minutes of the September 9, 2021, meeting were made by Councilmembers Whitney and Day respectively and carried unanimously.


Section 8 Administrator Merunda Brown gave her regular report on the workings of the Section 8 Program and its positive influence on City. She noted that the new website is up and running and urged public use of it. She stated that the program now covers 48 units which includes four new landlords.


Councilmember Day moved for approval of a proposal made to the City by Terracon Consultants, Inc, allowing the consultants to write a grant for the City free of charge to be submitted to the EPA Brownfields program for cleanup of a chosen area of the town that would allow business development. Councilmember Whitney seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Whitney motioned for approval of A Resolution Authorizing the City of Tallulah Through Its Mayor to Make Application for the FY 2022 Louisiana Community Block Grant Program for a Grant in Order to Make Improvements to City Of Tallulah streets (Tank Street, University Street and Florida Street). Councilmember Sims seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned on motion and second of Councilmembers Whitney and Sims respectively which carried unanimously.
