During the time allowed, no comments were made from the audience regarding any items on the agenda,

Motion and second to approve minutes of the August 26, 2021 meeting were made by Councilmembers Whitney and Sims respectively and carried unanimously.

Ms. Myra Gatling-Akers, representing Mary Bird Cancer Center, gave an overview of the center's cancer screening activities in the area through the use of mobile units free of charge to citizens. The cancer center has been in the business of early detection of cancer for more than 17 years and has an impressive record of diagnosing over 700 cancers during that time.


Councilmember Robinson moved for approval of a contract between the City of Tallulah and North Delta Regional Planning and Development District, Inc, for the purpose of redistricting of the City based on new numbers from the 2020 Decennial Census.
