

Regular Council Meeting  
City of Tallulah  
August 26, 2021

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, August 26, 2021, at 5:30 P. M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed for a moment of silent prayer.

Time was allowed for public comments on items of the agenda, but there was none.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the August 12, 2021 meeting with corrections were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Day respectively and carried unanimously.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the August 23, 2021, meeting with corrections were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Whitney respectively and carried unanimously.

Cancer Treatment Center representative, Ms. Mary Bird Perkins, postponed her presentation until next regular meeting on September 9, 2021.

Councilmember Robinson moved for adoption of A Resolution Authorizing the Zoning Designation as Commercial for St. Edwards Catholic Church. Councilmember Scott seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Councilmember Whitney moved for adoption of A Resolution Granting the Right of Ingress and Egress Passageway for Brushy Development Corporation on Land Adjacent to that of the City of Tallulah. Councilmember Day seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

Motion and second to enter Executive Session were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Day respectively and carried unanimously.

In Executive Session, City Attorney David Doughty briefed the Mayor and Council on legal issues regarding the City.
