

Regular Council Meeting
City of Tallulah
January 13, 2022

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, January 13, 2022, at 5:30 P. M., in the Council Room Chamber of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed for a moment of silent prayer.

Time was allowed for any comments from the public regarding items on the agenda, but there was none.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the December 16, 2021 meeting were made by Councilmembers Whitney and Sims respectively and carried unanimously.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the December 28, 2021 meeting were made by Councilmembers Day and Whitney respectively and carried but with an abstention from Councilmember Robinson.

Councilmember Robinson moved for approval of an occupational license submitted by LeKetha Payne for "Trustworthy Tax Solutions", LLC. Councilmember Day seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

No action was taken on the application submitted by LaTonya Thomas due to her absence. Motion and second to that effect were made by Councilmembers Robinson and Day respectively and carried unanimously.

Councilmember Robinson moved for approval of A Resolution of the City of Tallulah to Refund Excess Water Chargers. Councilmember Sims seconded, and subsequent roll call vote is shown below. The approved refund would involve the rate increase that had been in effect for seven months.


