

Regular Council Meeting
City of Tallulah
January 27, 2022

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, January 27, 2022, at 5:30 P. M., in the Council Room of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed time for silent prayer.

During the time allowed, there were no comments of significance from the public regarding items on the agenda.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the January 7, 2022, meeting were made by Councilmembers Whitney and Day respectively and carried unanimously.

Motion to approve the business license application submitted by LaTanya Thomas for a health service was made by Councilmember Robinson, seconded by Councilmember Day, and carried unanimously.

Motion and second to approve the business license application of Derrick Jackson for a sports bar were made by Councilmembers Day and Robinson respectively and carried unanimously.

Councilmember Sims moved for approval of a United States Department of Agriculture Rural Development Rural Utilities Service Grant Resolution. Councilmember Day seconded, and a roll call vote is shown as follows:


