Special Council Meeting City of Tallulah June 6, 2024

A special meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, June 6, 2024, at 5:30 P.M., in the Council Room Chember of Tallulah City Hall.

Mayor Charles M. Finlayson called the meeting to order, led the Pledge of Allegiance, and allowed for a moment of silent prayer followed by Councilmember Wells who also gave prayer.

Mayor Finlayson reported all the steps the City has taken in order to bring it to its present status regarding total rehabilitation of the City's water plant and plant operations. He explained that all options for revitalizing the City's water system had been exhausted with no clear-cut way to accomplish the task. He stated that the action of receivership by the State of the City's water system was on the table, and that the State had already begun its inspection of the water plant. He urged that the receivership be approved by the Council as it would produce the best alternative for the City that is having to depend on a dilapidated water system existing in an emergency situation

City Attorney Pamela Grady, CREWS GRADY PLLC, on June 6, released to the public a complete letter/guide listing her legal procedures accomplished on the matter as well as her response to legal questions posed concerning state receivership of the City's water system.

During the Council Meeting, all citizens who wanted to speak on the situation were encouraged to make their wishes known, and audience participation was strong.

Motion to approve Sustainability Partners participation in construction of a new water plant without state joint receivership were made by Councilmembers Wells and Harris respectively, and a roll call vote is shown as follows:
