Regular Council Meeting City of Tallulah September 14, 2023

A regular meeting of the Mayor and City Council was held on Thursday, at 5:30 P. M. in the Council Room of Tallulah City Hall.

During the time allowed for public comments on the agenda, Mr. Antonio Wilson expressed his belief that some prior minutes should be further corrected, and that more detail should be included.

Motion and second to approve minutes of the September 14, 2023 meeting were made by Councilmembers Houston and Scott respectively and carried.

Councilmember Scott moved for approval of A Resolution Regarding A Lease Purchase Agreement For The Purpose Of Financing "Police Pursuit Vehicles". Councilmember Houston seconded, and a roll call vote is shown as follows:

As a requirement of the LCDBG upcoming street project, Councilmember Harris moved for approval of A Residential Antdisplacement Relocation Assistance Plan Under Section 104(d) Of The Housing And Community Development Act Of 1974, As Amended. Councilmember Day seconded, and motion carried unanimously.

During his update, Mayor Finlayson commented on the current street project stating that Dreher Contracting, Bastrop, Louisiana, was awarded the bid of \$1,161,230, and will begin rehabilitation of Florida, University, and Tank Streets within 30 days. Construction completion should be by mid-March 2024.

Public comments consisted primarily of a discussion on political boundaries within the City as well as the status of Kelly's Apartments regarding city limits.

There being no further business to discuss, the meeting was adjourned with motion and second from Councilmembers Day and Houston respective which carried unanimously.
