### Contractual Agreement

**This Contractual Agreement** is made and entered into on April 23, 2025, by and between the City of Tallulah, located at 204 North Cedar Street, Tallulah, LA 71282, hereinafter referred to as "City," and Tallulah Construction, Inc., with a mailing address of P.O. Box 224, Tallulah, LA 71284, hereinafter referred to as "Contractor."

### 1. Job Description

The Contractor has visited the site and presented a proposal for the project at the Tallulah Police Department, which was approved by the Tallulah City Council on April 10, 2025. The Contractor agrees to perform the reconstruction of the garage into offices according to the plans and specifications submitted. The scope of work includes, but is not limited to, demolition, construction of offices and stalls, installation of electrical and HVAC systems, and painting, as detailed in the proposal dated April 8, 2025, attached hereto and incorporated herein.

### 2. Contract Price and Payment Terms

The total cost for the work is \$125,990.00, payable in four equal installments of \$31,497.50, contingent upon the progress of the work.

#### 3. Performance Bond or Letter of Credit

All work will be performed in a workmanlike manner and guaranteed for a period of one year from the date of completion. The Contractor agrees to correct any defects in materials or workmanship that arise during this period at no additional cost to the City.

### 7. Compliance with Laws

The Contractor shall comply with all applicable federal, state, and local laws, regulations, and ordinances in the performance of this contract.

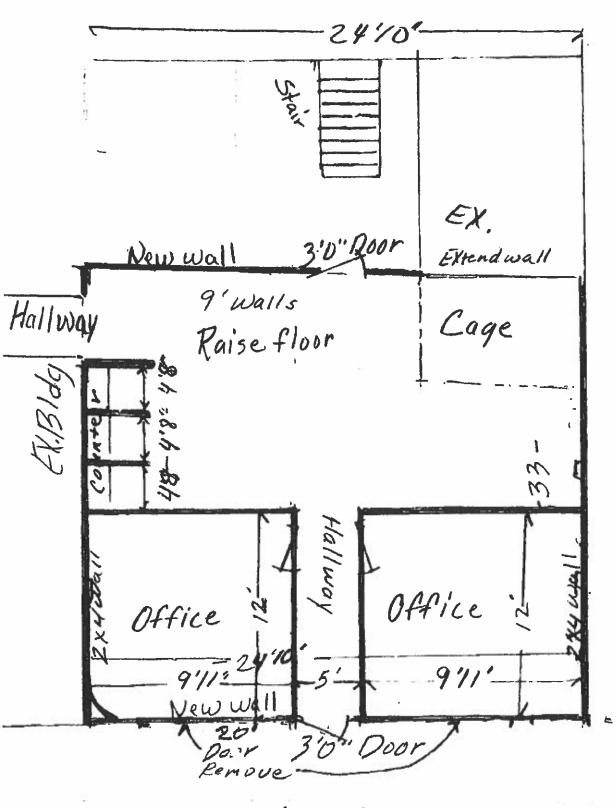
